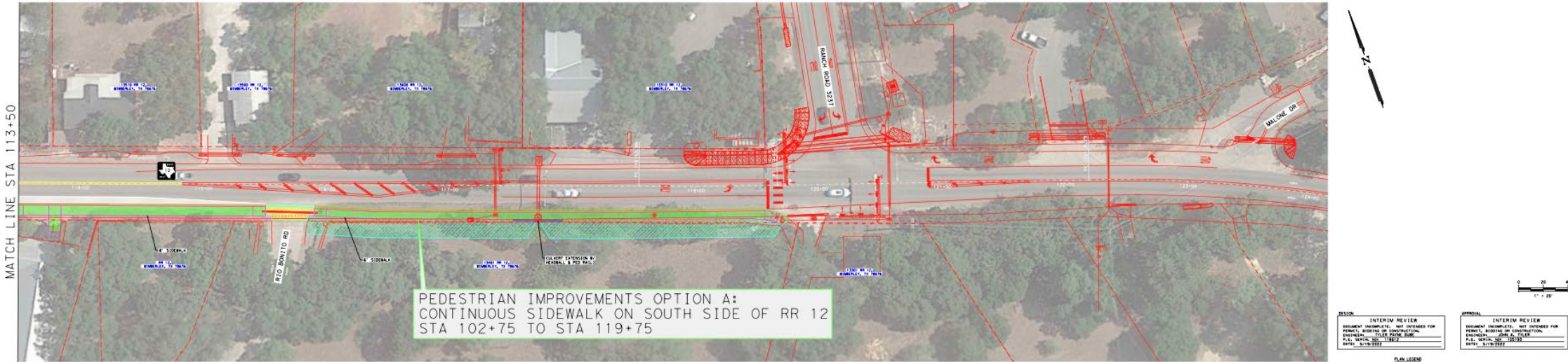
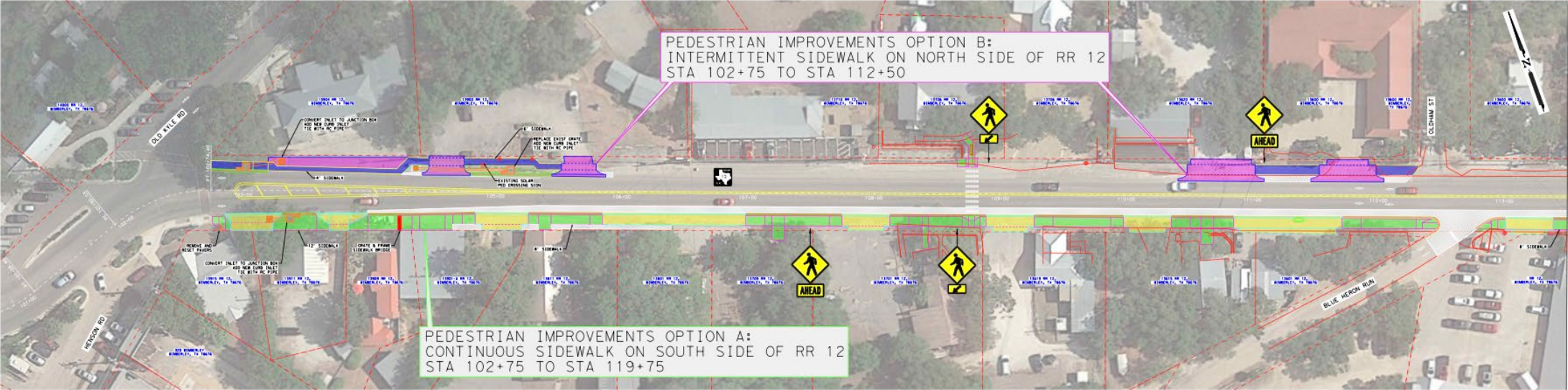

OLD KYLE ROAD BETWEEN RM 12 AND FM 3237:

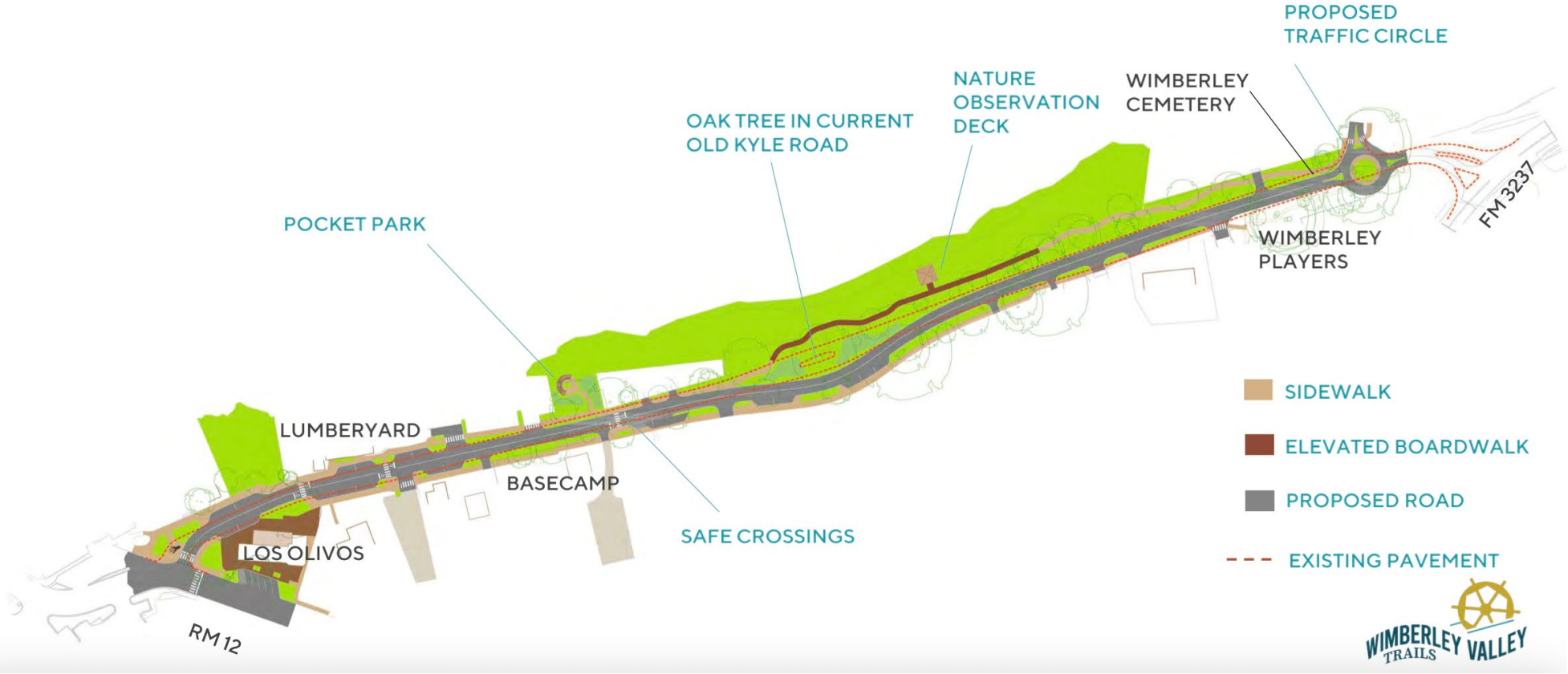
- Safety concerns

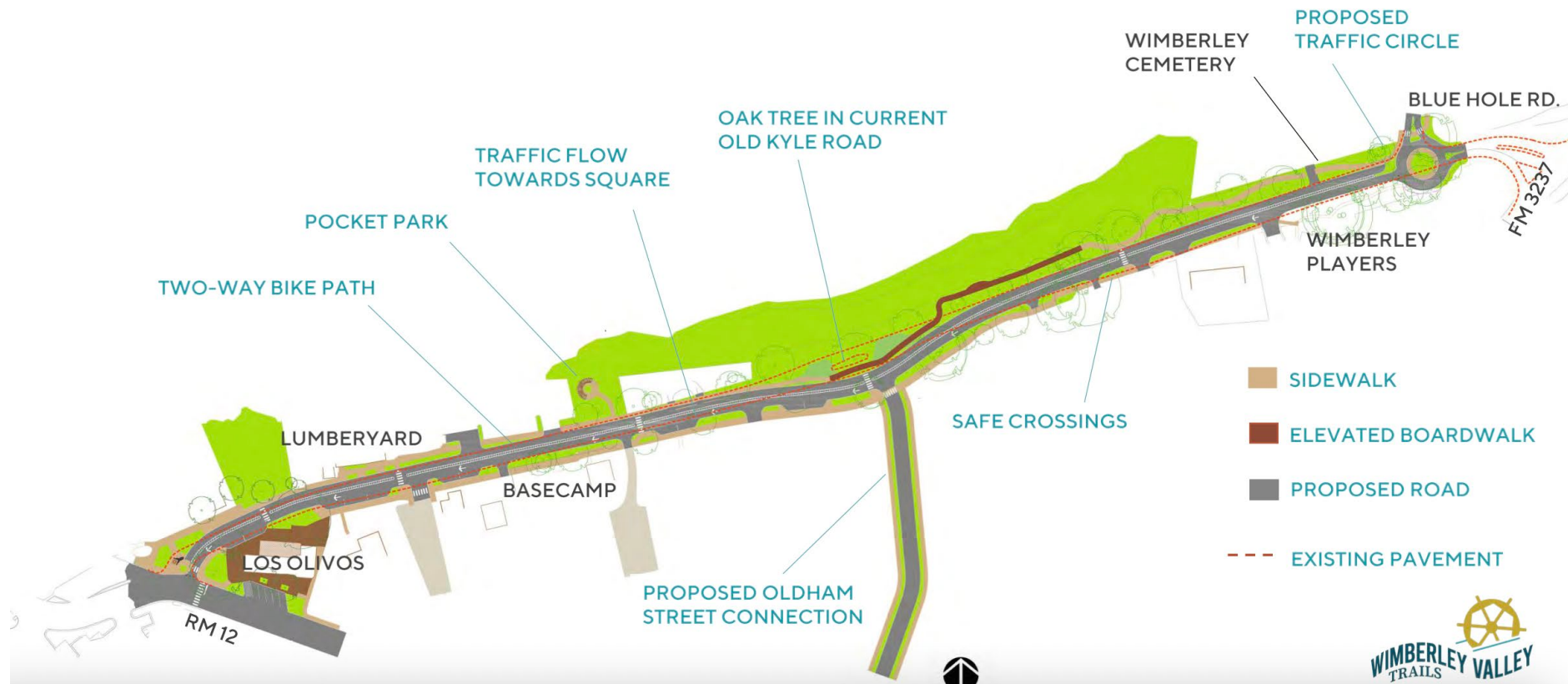

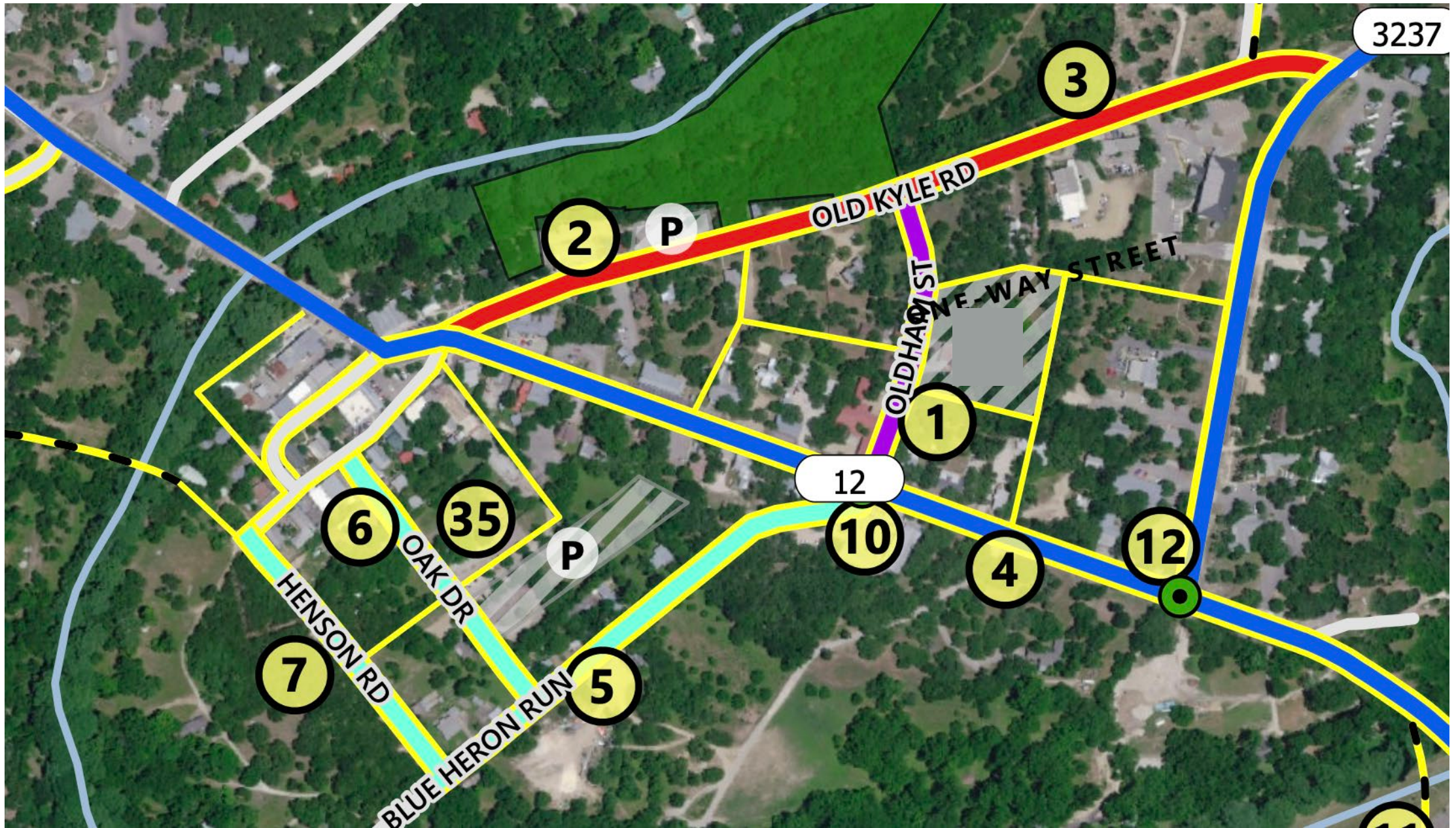
